ORDER:

In the reference 1st read above, Government have issued detailed guidelines to sanction financial assistance to ST students for pursuing Higher Studies in Post Graduate Courses in Foreign Universities from the Academic year 2013-14 under "Ambedkar Overseas Vidya Nidhi" Scheme. Subsequently, certain amendments were made in the scheme references 2nd to 3rd read above.

2. In the reference 3rd read above, Government have enhanced the Family Income ceiling limit upto Rs.3.00 lakhs per annum from all sources of SC/ST/BC/MW students to avail Overseas Scholarship to pursue higher studies at abroad.

3. Government have decided to enhance the income limit of student/parent from the existing limit to Rs.5 lakhs per annum for availing Overseas Scholarship.

4. Government, therefore, hereby enhance the income criteria i.e. family income limit (including the applicant), from the existing Rs.3.00 Lakhs per annum to Rs.5.00 lakhs per annum from all sources, in case of ST applicants, to avail the Scholarship under "Ambedkar Overseas Vidya Nidhi Scheme".

5. The Commissioner of Tribal Welfare, Telangana State, Hyderabad shall take necessary action accordingly.
