

Minutes of the State Level Screening Committee Meeting for Selection of SC Students Under Ambedkar Overseas Vidya Nidhi Scheme, to provide Financial Assistance for pursuing Higher Studies in Foreign Universities, held on 15-03-2025, at 3.00 P.M, at Conference Hall, Room No. (14), Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Secretariat, Hyderabad.

- 2) At the outset, the convener/ Commissioner(SCDD), welcomed all the State Level Committee members and briefed regarding preparation of Merit List of the students as per the guidelines issued in G.O. Ms. No. G.O.Ms.No:54 SCD (Edn) Dept., Dated: 28.06.2013, G.O.Ms.No.66 SCD (Edn) Dept., Dated: 09-11-2017 and G.O. Ms. No. 2 SCD (Edn.A1) Dept, Dt: 05-02-2021.
- 3) The committee members have verified the Check Slips of the students, and mandatory documents submitted by the concerned District Officers/Students, as follows.
 - GRE / IELTS/ TOEFL/PTE Score cards
 - I-20/ Offer letter/CAS of the Universities.
 - Graduation Memo
 - Passport/VISA
 - Caste details issued by the Mee-Seva
 - Income details issued by the Mee-Seva
 - Aadhar card
 - Bank pass book
- 4) For Fall intake of 2024, (309) applications have been registered under the Ambedkar Overseas Vidya Nidhi Scheme.
- 5) Target of the intake is (105) candidates only.
- 6) The Merit list of the candidates has been prepared with 60% weightage on Degree Marks + 40% weightage on Test Scores GRE/GMAT/PTE/TOEFL/IELTS, as per the prescribed guidelines under the scheme. In case the student submitted (2) test Scores, the highest score has been considered for preparation of merit.
- 7) The Graduation percentage as mentioned in the Memos by the Universities has been taken as it is, in case of CGPA, the formula of the concerned Universities has been ^{ad}opted for conversion of percentage.
- 8) 33% reservation for Women candidates and 10% for Humanities, Economics, Accounts, Arts and Law students, is followed in selection.
- 9) The Committee has recommended to call for the objections online, on the merit list of candidates.

9) The students shall submit their objections if any, in online, within (10) days from placing the merit list in e-pass portal.
